Cerf Island Resort - *the Seychelles*

Representation

Your holiday is all about rest, relaxation and rejuvenation so take a few moments before you go to read through our 'Holiday Essentials' which is designed so that you may benefit from our first hand knowledge and experience of Cerf Island Resort and ensure you have an enjoyable trip. We are represented in the Seychelles by Creole Travel Services who are on hand throughout your stay, should you need assistance they will be there to help. Telephone them on (248) 297 000.

Cerf Island is reached by a 15 minute road transfer followed by a 15 minute boat ride from Eden Island Marina.

Upon arrival at Mahé International Airport you will be met by a representative of Creole Travel Services who will provide you with a welcome pack and direct you to your waiting transfer.

Cerf Island Resort

Cerf Island Resort is situated within the Ste. Anne Marine Park just 5km east of Mahé.

Check-in time is 1400, check-out time is 1200 noon.

Cerf Island Resort's fine dining restaurant, Restaurant 1756, is perched on a cliff top and offers a selection of traditional Creole and international cuisine. The Cocktail Bar at the entrance to the restaurant is open for lunch and dinner. Adjacent to the swimming pool, the Pool Bar offers light lunches, snacks and refreshing drinks throughout the day. Private dining can be arranged at virtually any location on the premises – with options ranging from a romantic candlelit beach meal to dinner served on your balcony (please note a local supplement will apply). The dress code at the restaurant is smart casual – shorts, trainers and sleeveless T-shirts are not permitted in the evenings.

The marine park waters around the island offer fabulous opportunities for snorkelling. Island boat excursions, scuba diving and fishing trips can also be arranged and paid for locally.

A walk to the viewpoint above the resort is not to be missed – it offers outstanding panoramic views of Mahé, Ste. Anne Island and the marine national park.

Alternatively pamper yourself in the resort's private mini-spa which offers a range of massages and beauty treatments. All treatments are payable locally.

Facilities for children

Whilst children 8 and over are welcome at Cerf Island Resort, there is no dedicated kids' club available.

The cost of your accommodation includes:

- Half Board - breakfast and a 4 course dinner daily in Restaurant 1756 (excluding drinks)
- Use of pedalos, kayaks and snorkelling equipment
- Use of the swimming pool
- A selection of compact discs, DVDs and board games are available for loan

Cerf Island Resort offers an option for you to prepay for your meals and this provides great value for money as well as the peace of mind of being able to budget more accurately before your travel. Your confirmation invoice will detail the meal plan you have booked. Food & drink in the Seychelles can be more expensive than you'd expect and a meal for two with a bottle of wine at a local restaurant on Mahé is likely to cost around GBP 70.



In addition to the facilities offered for a standard booking, the following meal plans are available to book and can be prepaid:

- Full Board – lunch in Restaurant 1756 (excluding drinks)
- All Inclusive – poolside lunch plus unlimited soft drinks, water, house beers and house wines by the glass from 1756 restaurant, the pool bars and the minibar only. NB. Branded beverages, cocktails, and room service are NOT included.

Extra information

It is worth remembering that the Seychelles is a tropical destination. We strongly advise that you take sufficient quantities of your preferred insect repellent and to wear long-sleeves and trousers in the evening, especially at dusk when mosquitoes are at their most active.

Please note that the majority of hotels, restaurants, shops and services only accept payment in Euro, GBP and USD or by credit card. If you require Seychelles rupees it is advisable to exchange only what you need on a day to day basis.
