Inflation would take the total to some £8 Billion in today's money.

To this must be added the further accumulated costs especially to the Taxpayer to bring the estimated total cost to £10 Billion.

As recorded in Hansard by Tony McNulty, The Parliamentary Under-Secretary of State for Transport, at 11.15am on 19 November 2003 (Column 287WH), consistent records only began recording "calls" on the Trust in 1978.

From 1978 to 2003, £160 million was called on to provide for travel organiser failure.

From 2003 to 2021, records are available in The Air Travel Trust's accounts although they are consistently out of date. The latest documentation only bears witness to 31 March 2021.
